APPLICATIONS: Applications accepted on a first come and invitational basis only. Team entry must include a copy of your USA Hockey Player Roster Form with a roster limit of (25). All players must meet eligibility requirements of: Mississippi Valley Club High School Association and/or Mid States High School Hockey Association. All players must have completed a USA Hockey IMR for the 2014-15 season to participate. Players cannot be added to teams once roster is submitted. Each team will provide to the tournament director the following:

- Copy of the Player Roster listing all player and coaches.
- Listing of the players full name, number, position.
- Listing of the coaches, team representative full names, addresses.

If a team is found to have violated the rules for entry their application may be disqualified with no refund of entry fees.

ENTRY FEE: \$750 per team.
\$400. Non-refundable deposit, must accompany entry form.

QUALIFICATION ROUND - ROUND ROBIN TOURNAMENT
June 1 through July 20
5 teams will play 4 games each to determine seeding for trophy rounds.

TROPHY ROUNDS

July 27, 2014

Teams will play for positions 1st through 4th place as determined by their combined points throughout the qualification round. Trophies will be awarded to first through fourth place teams.

2014 SUMMER MELTDOWN HIGH SCHOOL TOURNAMENT COMPETITION RULES

Playing Rules: USA Hockey Official Playing Rules. Except where noted.

Playing Time: Game time: 60:00 maximum – game clock will be reduced to 2 min if actual time gets to 5 minutes.
Warm-up: 3:00 run time.
Periods - 3: 12:00 minute stop time periods
Period break: 1:00 run time.
Time-outs: :30 one per-team per-game

Penalty Time: Minor: 2:00 stop time.
Major: 5:00 stop time.
Misconduct: 10:00 stop time.

Game Misconduct: Minor & suspension for the balance of that game, and the next game.

Match Penalty: Suspension for the balance of the game, tournament, and referral to the responsible league officials.

Officials: On-Ice: 2 -Referee,
Off-Ice: 1-Timekeeper provided by tournament,
Each team provides one-penalty box gate keeper.

Protests:

- a) Referee's judgment calls are non-protest actions.
- b) Referee's decisions that are in conflict with non-judgment rules may be protested.
- c) Protests may only be lodged by the Head Coach and be filed within 1-hour of the conclusion of the game in question.
- d) The burden of proof in all protests is on the person lodging the protest.
- e) Protests can be received only by the Rules Chairman and the rules committee's decision is final.

Scoring System: The tournament is an open format game point system. **NO TIE GAMES!** All games tied at the end of regulation play will be decided by a "Three Man Shootout." The team that has the fewest amount of penalties in regulation play will have the choice of shooting first or second in the shootout. The Team that scores the most goals in the Shootout wins the game. If a tie exists after all three shooters have taken their shots, a "Sudden Death Shootout" will commence. No players can shoot twice until all players have shot once. Penalized players, who have not completed their penalty obligation, will not be allowed to participate in the shootout. Head Coaches must submit a Shootout List prior to the start of the game. Failure to do so will result in a 2:00 minor penalty for Delay of Game.

2-points for game win.
0-points for game loss.

Seeding Tie Breakers: To determine seeding for trophy games: If only two teams are tied using the point system, then the total points acquired in any head-to-head game will determine the tie-breakers. If head-to-head does not break the tie or if more than two teams are tied, the following will be used to determine position - after adjusting the score of the winning team of each game to a maximum of five goal differential:

- a) Subtracting goals-against from goals-for with the position being determined in order of the greatest surplus.
- b) If still tied, dividing goals-for by goals-against with the position being determined in order by the greatest quotient.
- c) If still tied, then the fewest goals allowed will determine position.
- d) If still tied, then the fewest penalty minutes (10 minutes for a game misconduct) will determine position in head-to-head competition.

If a tie still exists, then (a) through (d) will be applied, in order, for the last game played, then the first game played until the tie is broken.
